BY-LAWS

ARTICLE I. MEMBERSHIP

1. Classes of Membership

A. General Members: you are eligible to become a member by completing an intensive WI AHEC program and submitting the WI AHEC Alumni Association registration.

B. Honorary Members: May be admitted as an honorary member if they are a healthcare professional and/or friend of AHEC and are voted in via the board.

2. Application and Approval Process

A. General applications will be accepted through the online system. All those applying will be accepted unless need for review by board of directors.

B. Regional representatives will welcome new members.

ARTICLE II. BOARD OF DIRECTORS.

1. Eligibility for office: Any general member is eligible to apply for an officer position on the Board of Directors. No person shall serve more than two consecutive terms in the same office.

2. Terms of office: Elected officers shall hold one year terms of office from August 1 to July 31.

3. Board Members

A. President: The President shall have duties associated with the presidential office or as may be determined by the Board of Directors.

B. Vice President: The Vice President shall have duties determined by the

Board of Directors.

C. Secretary: Secretary shall have the duties ordinarily associated with their office and other such duties as may be determined by the Board of Directors.

D. Outreach and Marketing: Outreach and Marketing shall have duties as described by the position title and other such duties as may be determined by the Board of Directors

E. Regional Representative(s): Regional Representative shall provide regional representation to the Board of Directors and perform a variety of duties as determined by the Board of Directors

F. AHEC state program representative (AHEC staff member). Shall serve as liaison to Wisconsin AHEC.

4. Composition of the Board: At least half of the Board of Directors must be of student standing. A member is considered to be of student standing if they are enrolled for one academic session during their term of office.

5. Voting: The Secretary will distribute the ballots by online survey to the members.

ARTICLE III. COMMITTEES

1. The Awards Committee shall consist of two officers and two general / Honorary members. They shall propose annual awards for approval by the Board.

2. The President has the authority to appoint temporary committees as needed.

ARTICLE IV. AMENDMENTS

1. The Board of Directors may adopt, alter, or amend the by-laws by a majority vote of the Board of Directors. Once approved, the amended by-laws will go into effect immediately.

ARTICLE V. DISSOLUTION

1. To dissolve this organization, it has to be voted and approved by the Board of Directors of Wisconsin AHEC.
