Students will gain an understanding of the role hospitals play in addressing community health needs, while working alongside Froedtert Health's Community Engagement Team. The intern will support efforts surrounding Froedtert Hospital's Community Health Improvement Plan (CHIP) focusing on Milwaukee County. Current priority areas include access to care, chronic disease, violence and behavioral health. Based on prior experiences, goals and interests, the intern will focus on one or more areas of the CHIP to draw connections between existing initiatives and CHIP priorities, and identify opportunities to expand programming and/or develop new and innovative programs.

As part of the Community Engagement Team, the intern will also:

- Collaborate with key stakeholders on behalf of an academic medical
- Participate in addressing identified health needs in the community
- Coordinate Froedtert Health's participation in community events, and attend when available (dependent on COVID-19 pandemic)
- Support the triannual community health needs assessment process.
