Welcome to the Advocates in Medicine Pathway 2.0 (AMP 2.0) student online application system! We are recruiting for our first AMP 2.0 cohort and our 5th overall AMP cohort. The application deadline is April 4th, 2024.

The program will run from September 2024 through August 2025, with virtual and in-person components. We highly recommend you review the full program details, FAQs, timeline, and the PDF application to prepare you for submitting this application at <https://bit.ly/AMP-Website>.

What is AMP 2.0?

AMP 2.0 is a revamped version of the AMP program. It is a medical school pathway program that supports the professional development of individuals from rural and economically or environmentally disadvantaged backgrounds who are interested in attending medical school. AMP aims to promote a diverse future healthcare workforce built around resilience, relationships, and system-based knowledge. Ten individuals are admitted into the program annually.

What are the qualifications?

- By the start of the program (September 2024), applicants must have junior or senior standing or have already attained a Bachelor's degree.
- Have a strong interest in attending medical school.
- Plan to apply to medical school in the next 1-2 years.

Preference is given to applicants who:

- Are interested in practicing medicine in north central Wisconsin
- Have faced significant challenges, limitations, or barriers on their journey to a career in medicine
- Individuals who are economically or environmentally disadvantaged and students from rural communities

What are the required documents for a complete application?

- Application: All questions must be answered, including a personal statement with background and career goals and how the AMP Program will support reaching these goals.
- A current transcript (official or unofficial)
- A current resume including volunteer and paid work experiences.

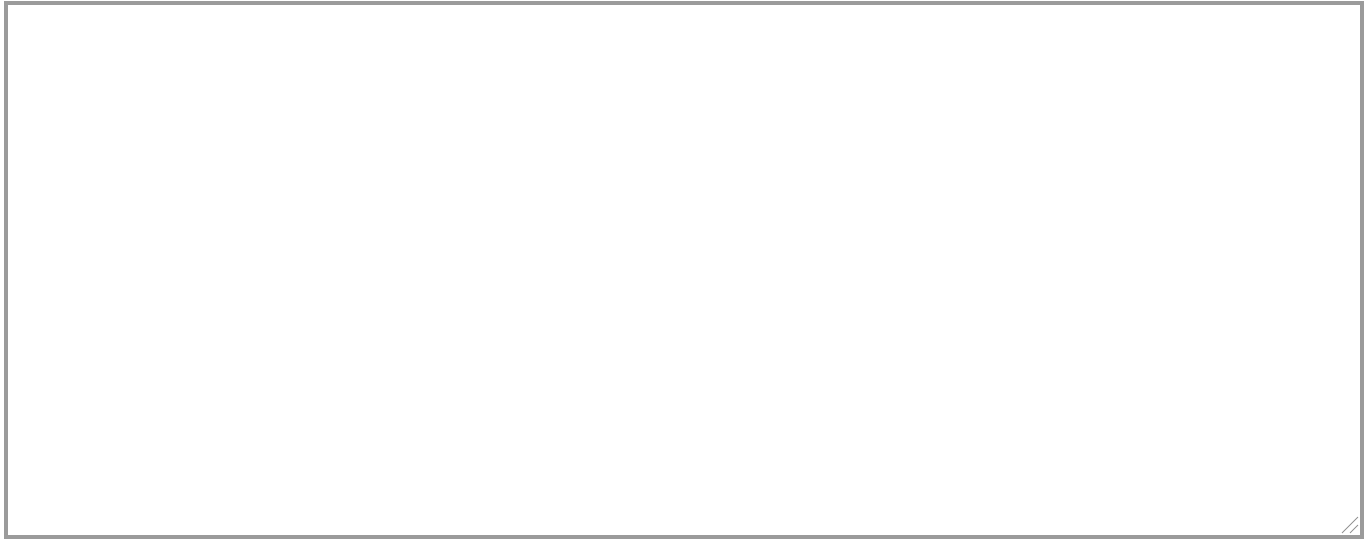
