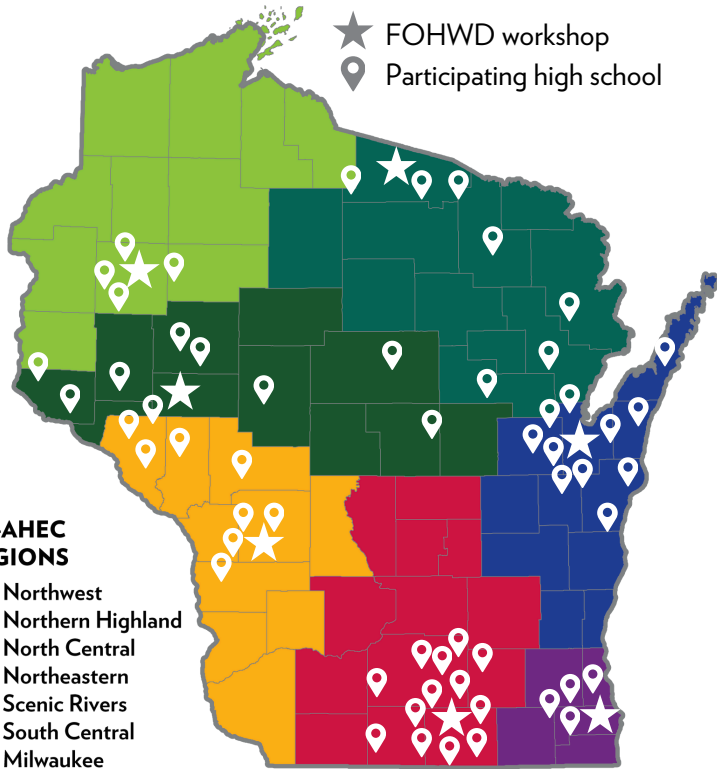




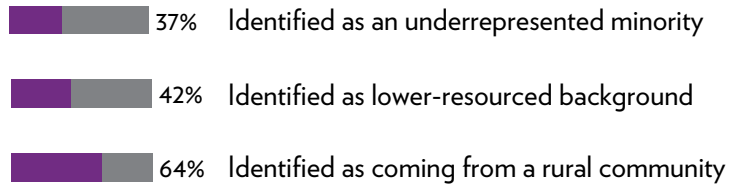
Future Oral Health Workforce Day (FOHWD) is a one-day workshop, hosted by and held within each of the seven Wisconsin AHEC regions, designed to increase the awareness of and interest in pursuing an oral health career among high school learners. Learners engage in hands-on activities and interact with workshop presenters who are currently practicing and aspiring oral health professionals, including dentists, dental hygienists, dental assistants, and dental lab technicians.

Map of approximate FOHWD workshop locations and participating high schools

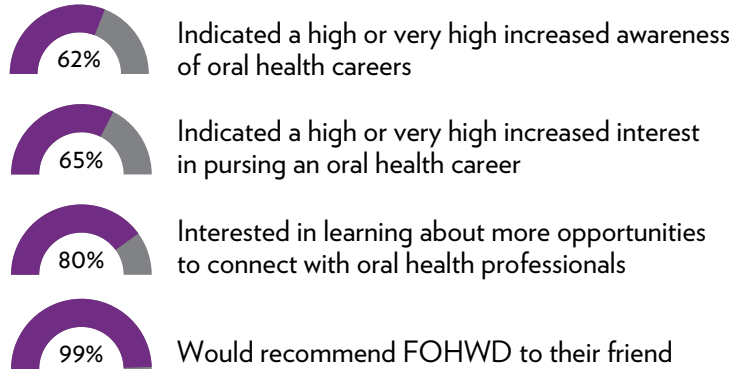


50% of participating high schools were located in a Dental Health Professional Shortage Area (HPSA)
