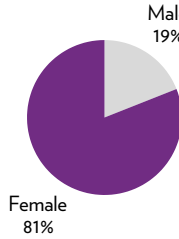

3. Focus On Healthcare Careers: I want to work in a health career in the future

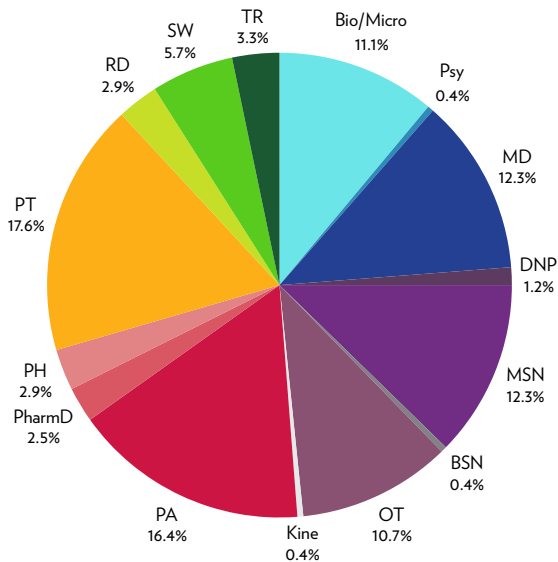
